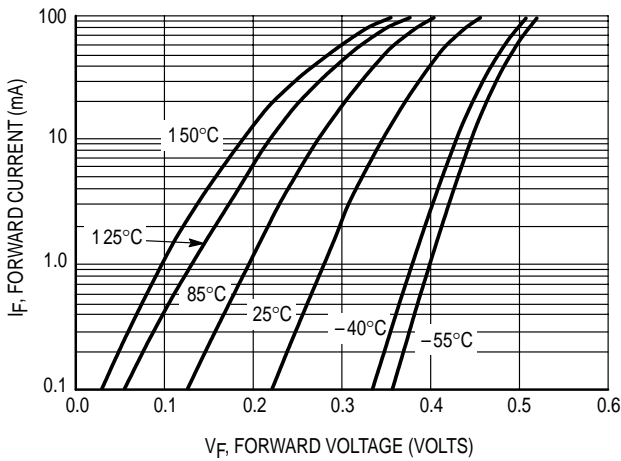

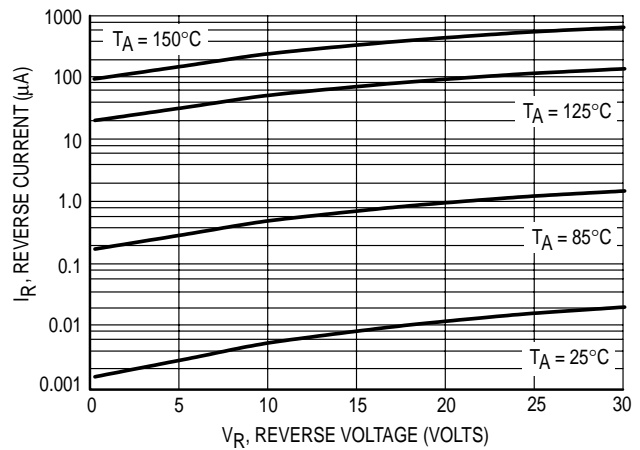

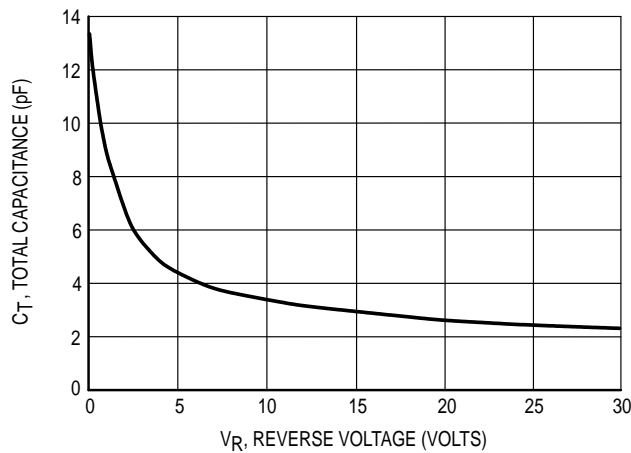
**Figure 1. Recovery Time Equivalent Test Circuit**

**Figure 3. Leakage Current**



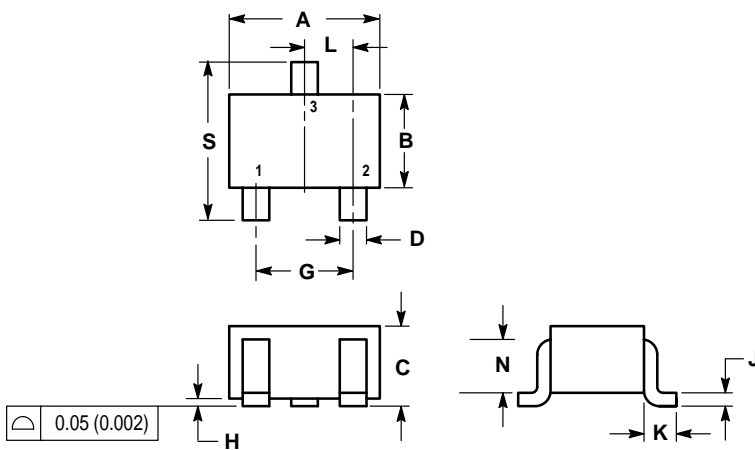
**Figure 4. Total Capacitance**
